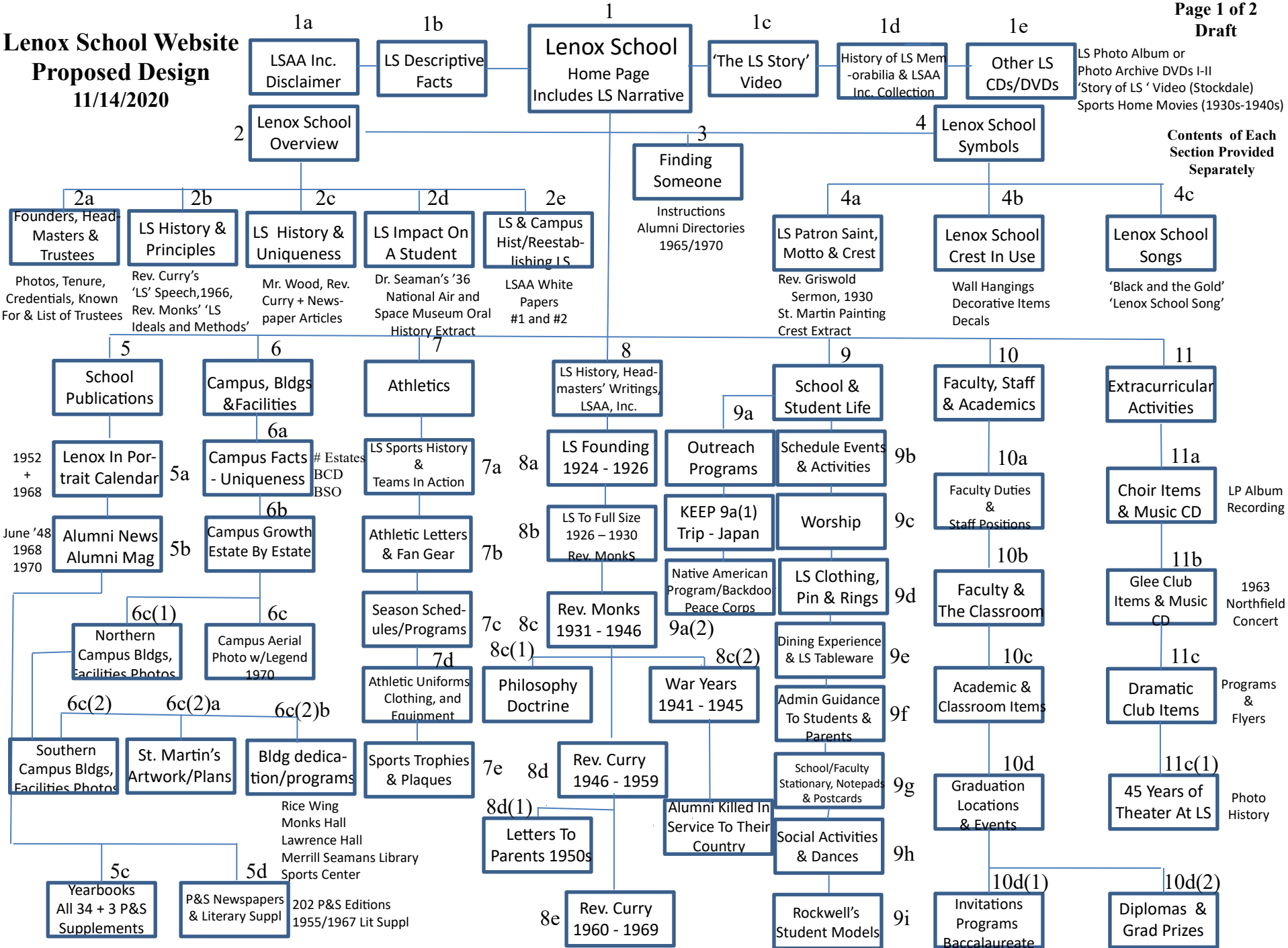

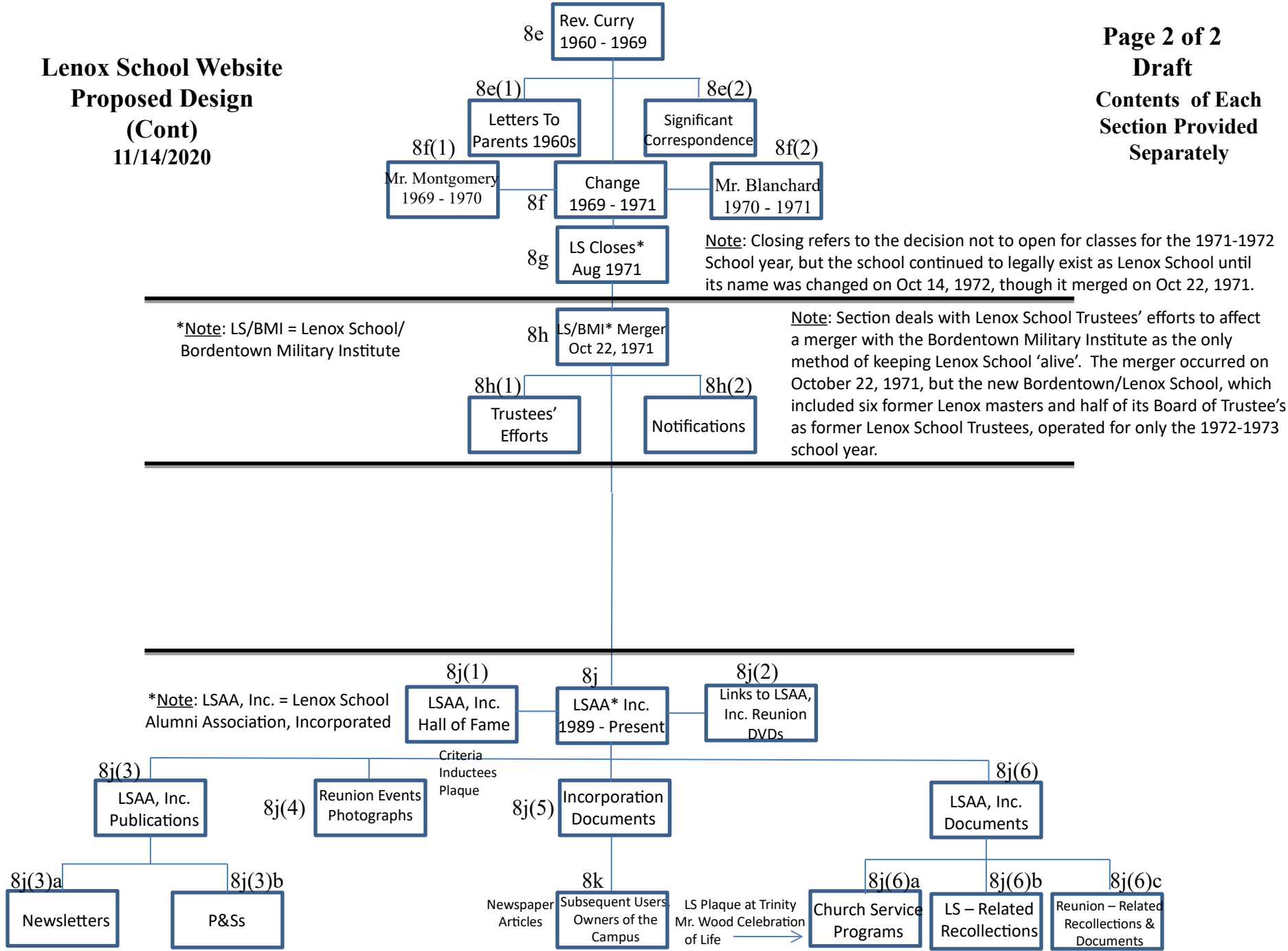

Note: Closing refers to the decision not to open for classes for the 1971-1972 School year, but the school continued to legally exist as Lenox School until its name was changed on Oct 14, 1972, though it merged on Oct 22, 1971.

Note: Section deals with Lenox School Trustees' efforts to affect a merger with the Bordentown Military Institute as the only method of keeping Lenox School 'alive'. The merger occurred on October 22, 1971, but the new Bordentown/Lenox School, which included six former Lenox masters and half of its Board of Trustee's as former Lenox School Trustees, operated for only the 1972-1973 school year.
